DRUGAČNI SVETovi – 5. MEDNARODNI NATEČAJ ZA MLADE FOTOGRAFE IZ SREDNJE IN JUGOVZHODNE EVROPE (CEE)

(English version below)

Natečaj za mlade in uveljavljajoče se ustvarjalce na področju sodobne avtorske fotografije, ki ga organizira Galerija Photon – Center za sodobno fotografijo iz Ljubljane. Prva nagrada prinaša 1.000€ podpore za produkcijo ter samostojno razstavo v Galeriji Photon. Izbrana deseterica avtorjev/ic pa se bo predstavila na skupinski razstavi v Ljubljani, na Dunaju in drugod!

Natečaj je odprt za avtorice in avtorje do 35. leta starosti (vključujoč letnik rojstva 1982), ki delujejo na področju CEE regije (Estonije, Latve, Litvije, Češke, Slovaške, Poljske, Madžarske, Romunije in Bolgarije) in v državah zahodnega Balkana / nekdanje Jugoslavije (Slovenija, Hrvaška, Bosna in Hercegovina, Srbija, Črna Gora, Kosovo, Makedonija) oziroma prihajajo iz teh držav in delujejo v mednarodnem prostoru.

O izboru avtorjev in del bo odločala neodvisna mednarodna komisija v sestavi **Branko Lenart** (fotograf in nekdanji profesor na College of Art and Design in University of Applied Sciences

Joanneum, Graz), **Michaela Bosakova** (Photon – Center za sodobno fotografijo, Dunaj), **Jean-Luc Soret** (kurator, Maison de la Photographie, Pariz) in **Anja Zver** (Kino Šiška, Ljubljana).

Natečaj nima predpisane teme. Sprejemamo dela, ki sodijo v široko paleto fotografskih in s fotografijo povezanih praks (fotografija, foto-montaža, foto-kolaž, foto-instalacija, apropiacija najdenih fotografij, itd.). Žirija bo višje ovrednotila dela, ki izkazujejo originalnost, nekonvencionalnost ter inovativnost tako v formalnem pristopu kot v izboru tem in konceptov!

Prijava naj vsebuje:

- avtorski portfolio največ dveh zaključenih avtorskih projektov ali projektov v procesu, vsak lahko vsebuje največ 20 fotografij, v resoluciji vsaj 1800 pikslov po daljši stranici v PDF ali JPG formatu,
- vsebinska utemeljitev projektov (obvezno v angleškem jeziku) do 1500 znakov;
- kratka biografija prijavitelja/ice;
- dodatne tehnične specifikacije: formate in dimenzije del, optimalni način predstavitve v razstavnem formatu;

Celotna prijava naj bo zapakirana v **eni zip datoteki** in naj bo poimenovana po principu

Ime_Priimek_NaslovProjekta.zip

Pošlje se skupaj z prijavnim obrazcom.

Izbrani avtorji bodo predstavljeni na skupinski razstavi v Galeriji Photon in Kinu Šiška v Ljubljani, ki se bo odprla **6. 11.** in bo trajala do **1. 12. 2017**. Razstava bo pospremljena z manjšim razstavnim katalogom, po Ljubljani pa bo potovala na Dunaj in v druga mesta partnerjev projekta (v letu 2016 so jo gostili v Bratislavi, Hiša Fotograije in Budimpešti, Galerija Viltin).

DIFFERENT WORLDS – 5TH INTERNATIONAL OPEN CALL FOR YOUNG PHOTOGRAPHERS FROM THE CENTRAL AND SOUTH-EAST EUROPE (CEE)

Open call for young and promising artists in the field of contemporary art photography organised by Photon Gallery – Centre for Contemporary Photography from Ljubljana. The first prize is € 1,000 for the production and solo exhibition at Photon Gallery. The selected ten artists will present their work at the group exhibition in Ljubljana, Vienna and elsewhere!

The call is open to artists up to 35 years of age (including those born in 1982) who work in the CEE region (Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland, Hungary, Romania and Bulgaria) and in the states of the western Balkans / former Yugoslavia (Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Montenegro, Kosovo, Macedonia) or who come from these states and work abroad.

The selection of the artists and the works will be in the hands of the independent international jury composed of **Branko Lenart** (a photographer and a former professor at College of Art and Design and University of Applied Sciences Joanneum, Graz), **Michaela Bosakova** (Photon – Centre for Contemporary Photography, Vienna), **Jean-Luc Soret** (curator, Maison de la Photographie, Paris) and **Anja Zver** (Kino Šiška Center for Urban Culture, Ljubljana).

There is no prescribed theme for the call. We accept the works in the wide range of photography and photography-related practices (photography, photomontage, photo-collage, photo-installation, appropriation of found photographs, etc.). The jury will evaluate higher those works which exhibit originality, unconventionality and innovation both in the formal approach as well as with regard to themes and concepts!

The application should include:

- author's portfolio of maximum two completed projects or projects in the process, each can include maximum 20 photographs, in the resolution of at least 1,800 pixels on the long side in PDF or JPG format;
- argumentation of the projects (in English) up to 1,500 characters;
- a short biography of the applicant;
- additional technical specifications: format and dimensions of the works, optimal way of presentation in the exhibition format.

The complete application should be packed in **one zip file** and renamed in format of Name_Surname_ProjectTitle.zip

You send it together with the application form.

The selected artists will be presented at the group exhibitions in Photon Gallery and Kino Šiška Center for Urban Culture in Ljubljana which will be open from **6th November** to **1st December 2017**. The exhibition accompanied by a catalogue will travel after Ljubljana to Vienna and other cities of the project partners (in 2016 it was hosted in Bratislava, The House of Photography and in Budapest, Viltin Gallery).
